Discussion Items:

- Leadership EXchange May event
 - Registration at ~40 community members. Continuing to engage to encourage participation
 - Feedback has indicated a number of conflicts with attending: vacations, graduations, health travel concerns, travel restrictions, budget restrictions
 - End of April/May/June is a busy pre-planned vacation time & graduation commencements
 - If attendance remains light, will mean more opportunities for one:one, intimate conversations. Program is shaping up to be high quality with facilitated conversations.
 - Good opportunity to expend energy to create a welcoming space for first attendees
 - Suggest a "first-timer" badge, opening keynote acknowledgement to new members & display photos, ask new folks to be a presenter
 - Feature the work they do/their focus
 - What they champion, what they're passionate about, what institution they're affiliated with
 - Also a benefit for individuals new to the community to see those details about everyone else
 - Many people are retiring and new folks are stepping in. Could have someone who has never been a CIO, or doesn't know us - we need to focus on those people and ensure they feel welcomed
- Alignment Survey, Next Steps
 - Responses from 234 organizations (voices include R1s, Masters, Affiliate members, TCUs). Offers great insight into which communities value various elements of Internet2's services, solutions, activities the most
 - Internet2 Exec team reviewing the report
 - Hoping to share results by May Leadership Exchange meeting
 - Identifying patterns and trends
 - Look at the roster for those registered for the May Leadership event. Put specific questions in front of them questions leaders should be thinking about.

• Like the idea of getting these things out in front of people in advance, could lead to richer conversations in person

New PAG members

- New members could potentially join us at the May meeting, definitely at the
 June meeting
 - Idea brought up previously of assigning a current CE PAG "buddy"
 - If the new people will be in Denver for the Leadership event, should meet up in person to make them feel welcome

 - Would need to coordinate meeting logistics (room rental, zoom cameras)
 - Combine May and June meetings in early June
 - Might get less attendance if we reschedule
 - Polling for a new date has not proven successful in the past
 - Skip May meeting altogether and keep the June meeting as scheduled
