Update on Five-Yr Roadmap Process (Glenn)

- Proposed process for synthesizing community input

Discussion:

- Current status we've received feedback widely, Ron Kraemer has done thorough job of documenting and tracking feedback received
- Moved to working on framing reviewing feedback, including each VP reviewing within their scope. Identified five categories of feedback received: 1) things we're already doing, 2) things incremental to current activities or could be done with adjustments (prioritization or resources), 3) items we may be doing but require significant scope change or resource impact, 4) pure greenfield (not currently doing but community has asked us to investigate or consider- example, standing up security operations center), and 5) other statements that aren't actionable
- Mike and Ana will work with this PAG between now and Community Exchange, at Leadership Exchange, and throughout the summer

- Realizing there will be discussions at Community Exchange, will a work in progress be shared for the April meeting? Would benefit those that in this group can't make it to Atlanta and allow them to be sure they have the opportunity to give feedback.
 - CE Leadership are meeting in Denver before our next PAG meeting so we should have items to share in both the April meeting and the Community Exchange.
- Notes the importance of providing any materials for review prior to the meeting.

Update on Fees Subcommittee (Dave G + PAG reps)

Discussion:

- Reviewed recommendations shared in the document
 - Welcome to schedule a meeting to discuss further if desired
- Noted that the new fees are tied to budget numbers, there's a linear number for schools
 - Noted there are institutions at the top end of the model (highest SC), but also an HSI so need to evaluate the role of such designations in calculating fees
 - Can the minimum be lowered and institutions with larger budgets step up to make up the difference?
- There is a balance in creating an exact model / fit to institutional demographics versus keeping it reasonably simple for example log fit is the best for our data, but that's difficult to describe, and the model is already challenging enough to describe
- Noting special cases at the bottom of the model (lower SCs) is not good, that segregates the population into better or "worse" categories,
- Support for the model overall but what / who are the outliers in the model the institutions who's SC will change a lot or a little?
- The change in the scale data from five years ago and now is significant, with a 5% cap on any overall increases there are a lot of institutions that will move in that direction perpetually and never pay their actual calculated SC
 - For example one institution grew like 40% both in operations and research. Some have had incredible growth spurts and some have had significant budget reductions
