

Baseline Expectations

- Foundational "Baseline Expectations for Trust in Federation" has 1-page of expectations for IdPs, SPs, & Federation Operators (http://doi.org/10.26869/TI.34.2)
- BE 1 required technical, admin, and security contacts and UI elements in metadata for "accurate, complete" metadata.
- BE 2 adds measures to meet general requirements for "generally accepted security practices" in the broad Baseline Expectations.

BE 2 requirements

- Add errorURL to all IdP metadata
- Add compliance with SIRTFI v1.0 trust framework defines processes and signaling for dealing with security incidents within the federation
- Add requirement for secure unbroken TLS for all end points SSLabs test suite a convenient tool; "grade" of A meets requirement; lower grade indicates need to mitigate risk







Home Stretch

- Federation Manager "enforces" BE components; that is the principal impact of the formal adoption of BE2 in July: updates to InC metadata require errorURL and SIRTFI, and they report last known SSLLabs TLS score.
- CTAB is working with operators and institutions to reach the community consensus goal of all entities meeting Baseline Expectations. CTAB anticipates some edge cases will require extensions or exceptions if participants provide rationale and plan.
