January 12, 2022

- Members approved the [December 2021 Summary](#) notes with no changes.
- On behalf of Sean, Bobby introduced the topic of NET+ services awareness through professional organizations such as [NAEP](#), [NACUA](#), and [NACUBO](#). Members noted their institutions' participation in these organizations is varied but provide potential opportunities for building community. An idea for NET+ to host confidential, topical small-group conversations was introduced with positive feedback from the committee. Members also discussed their RFP processes and noted the variations in responsibility/authority of staff with roles in IT, Procurement, and Vendor Management.
- Bobby led a discussion on challenges for the spring semester due to the pandemic. Themes discussed included choices for virtual versus in-person instruction, potential long-term health effects on students' learning, admission application trends, and the tension between remote work options and local IT employee markets.
