  - UVA it is just now coming up as a small issue that is growing but they haven't solved it
  - MattR- thinks they do have a lot of China students in town, not sure of the impact they will have
  - Rutgers- most of their student body comes from New Jersey. Problem isn't solved for the China students. Not just zoom . will most likely be remote in the fall. And will limit to 25% on site. Not a new issue for them.
  - UMBC- more India than China- 90% remote, still waiting to see how it will play out

- JS- what is the cost to do these? Should I2 be doing more in cloudbrokering? w/ EDUCAUSE restructure. Maybe offerings being bought through a regional. I2 should help lead the way in how we get the community moving. There are some folks that do have time to interact. (target a level or two below CIO).
  - +1 from MattR- having callers from elsewhere on the calls is good
  - MicheleN- would not pull back on programming, who knows where the tolerance will be with online programming. Hard to judge where people will hold and not hold. A lot of CIO's are at their limit. If at a reasonable cost for I2 then why not.
    - Educause- opportunity for HP to talk to John about supporting Educause
- Update on activities with Google: gSuite, contact tracing
  - MicheleN- institutions don't know what to do about contact tracing, it is a very manual activity. Don't want to be in the contact tracing business. More complicated than it sounds. People are in a listening mode. +1 Virginia
  - VirginiaE- our Health division has taken this on. Students are coming back to campus in August- w/ isolation, quarantine, distancing
  - MattR-Health center folks taking the lead, IT in the ready but not anything more
  - MarkHenderson- not an IT driven initiative, but standing in the ready
  - JackS- how do you show who has gone through the training, who's in compliance, where have faculty been? Building the dashboard,
    - UCSD-Did a webinar in June on business processes to do testing on 5K/ month.
  - KevinM-Everyone will need to integrate data that you might not have done before, Google might have data that could be used. Managing gatherings and incidents
- Other topics
  - Comments on Models for your institutions:
    - +1 on Jack's comments about rethinking community and the role that Net+ may play, as well as how I2 may need to invest more in cloud services.
    - Look at I2-Online - particularly curation of presentations into topics and re-presentation (empowering).
    - More instructional webinars - such as "how to best structure Google Drive, Secure vs group and permission management. Etc
