


"Balkanized" Institutional Organization (hyper-decentralization)

(We have a lot of them...)




Moving Toward Coherence


- Advising Architecture Review Board (AARB)

Increased Understanding through Enterprise Architecture






What does the future hold?

Real-World Impact? Reduce Struggle and System Complexity = Big Win


