Cyber Security Awareness Tips for Adults, Educators, Kids and Organizations

Adults and Educators

- Establish Internet rules
- Be informed and involved with your children's Internet activity
- Create a safe haven
- Place the computer in a central location
- Be sure your computer has anti-virus software and a firewall installed
- Know the cyber space lingo
- Use filters and parental control software
- Use hard to guess passwords
- Report any suspicious activity

Kids

- Always ask for permission from a parent/guardian or teacher before releasing any personal information
- Never talk to strangers on the Internet
- Tell a trusted adult if you feel uncomfortable about any situation on the Internet
- Never meet strangers in-person that you met on the Internet
- Never go into chat rooms unless you have parental/guardian permission
- Report any cyber bullying incident to a trusted adult or teacher
- Don't click on links that you are not familiar with and don't download files without adult permission

Organizations

- Designate a principal individual responsible for cyber security
- Know how to recognize that you might have a cyber security problem
- Understand how to deal with cyber security problems
- Physically protect equipment
- Protect essential hardware/software
- Control access
- Protect information
- Implement training and awareness programs
- Develop Internet and acceptable use policy
- Take steps to securely dispose of storage media and equipment
