- Forum to share learnings and develop new insights and practical recommendations
- Guided by a Smart Campus CIO Advisory Council
- Create focused task forces to support collaborative development of practical recommendations

Smart Campus Initiative: IoT Systems Risk Management Task Force

- GOAL: Develop thoughtful and tangible approaches to IoT systems implementation and management that integrates systems risk mitigation with service delivery in Higher Education for optimal effectiveness
- OUTCOMES: Identify & prioritize 3-5 specific areas for further work, culminating in development of tangible and actionable processes and methods. Examples would include, but not be limited to:
 - IoT Systems vendor management approaches
 - Development of common 'backends' for IoT systems
 - Development of network segmentation/microsegmentation strategies for IoT systems
- Development of systems cost estimating tools
 & approaches
- Development of risk language & risk categories
- Explore partnership opportunities with benchmarking & analytics
- Explore organizational cultural barriers to successful implementations
