InCommon MFA Support Entity Attribute

Definition

The InCommon MFA Support Entity Attribute, identified by the URI http://xxxxx, is used by Identity Providers to assert compliance with the criteria of the InCommon MFA Profile and the InCommon Base Level Profile. I think it's needed for purpose 3 below.*] The entity attribute is self-certified; federations may associate it with any IdP whose operator claims that compliance.

Purpose

The MFA Support Entity Attribute is intended to be used for the following purposes:

- 1. As a filter for constructing an SP's discovery interface, when the SP will not accept authentication that does not meet the criteria of the InCommon MFA Profile.
- 2. As evidence to increase an SP operator's confidence in MFA authentication performed by the IdP.
- 3. To provide information that can be used by an SP to tailor its authentication flow to the capabilities of the IdP.
