

Deprovisioning report

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The Grouper Deprovisioning Report should be used in cases where a deprovisioning administrator doesn't deprovision certain memberships /privileges. This can be due to:


- Human intervention is required (someone wants to see it)
- The system of record is outside of Grouper and loaded in
- a group shouldn't be deprovisioned (e.g. lockout group)

The deprovisioning report can be viewed by the object admins (or to a user who has UPDATE/READ privileges for the group). You can initiate the Deprovisioning Report as shown here:
