Working Groups

- 1. IdP as a Service (IdPaaS) Working Group
 - a. Community requirements gathering and recommendations for an InCommon-branded hosted solution
 - b. Will likely help with the Long Tail and R&S
 - c. Requires participation by cohorts that don't usually participate
 - d. Vendors will be involved
 - e. Wiki space with charter and list info
- 2. Federation 2.0 (REFEDS) Working Group
 - i. TAC member Judith Bush (OCLC) is co-chair
 - a. TAC participation
 - b. Wiki and meeting notes
- 3. OIDC/OAuth Deployment Working Group

Other Work Items

- 1. RA21
 - a. Assess the "fit" of an InCommon-run IdP discovery persistence service
 - b. Update 5/16: GEANT will be hosting a beta service; circle back when beta launches
- 2. FIM4R Recommendations for InCommon
 - i. Invest in Areas to Support Collaboration-as-a-Service
 - ii. Increase Focus on Sustainability Practices
 - iii. Increase Research Representation in All Levels of FIM Governance
 - a. Responding to the requirements of researchers, a key audience
 - b. Will help with IdPs not providing attributes to R&S SPs
 - c. IdPaaS might meet some of the recommendations
- 3. Collaboration with CACTI/CTAB
 - a. Representatives (not chairs) to attend meetings
 - b. Update 5/16: completed

2019 Second Half

The work items for the second half of 2019 are:

- 1. Follow up to the Streamlining SP Onboarding Working Group
- 2. Follow up to the Attributes for Collaboration and Federation Working Group
 - a. The TAC is reviewing the draft of InCommon's response to the above two groups through February
 - b. Update 5/23: The recommendations the above two working groups made are planned or underway InCommon work items

- 3. Deployment Profile Working Group
 - a. Follow up after hiatus and Kantara ratification of revised SAML2int
 - b. Create an R&E specific profile to layer on top of SAML2int
 - i. Update 5/23: Likely kick-off in September/October
 - ii. Update 9/19: Item moved to draft 2020 plan
 - c. Might factor into Baseline, badging, automated testing
- 4. Development of a test InCommon federation
 - a. Working group to be chartered for requirements gathering late or early 2020
 - b. Update 9/19: Item moved to draft 2020 plan
- 5. Badging for Participants and maturity model outline for adoption of federation technologies and protocols
 - a. Update 5/23: A sub-group with members of CTAB and TAC is working on this
- 6. Address new TAC member onboarding and communication gaps

Parking Lot

- 1. SAML SP front end
 - a. SPs that don't play nice with InCommon and SAML
 - b. Might get addressed later in Federation 2.0
- 2. ADFS as an IdP
 - a. Requirements gathering, centralizing documentation, potentially working with Microsoft to implement changes/requirements
 - b. IdPaaS work could make this moot
 - c. In the spring, CAF and SWAMID starting using ADFSToolkit, which augments ADFS
