## Troubleshooting

- The directory `registry-source/` contains a `.htaccess` with necessary `mod_rewrite` directives. Not all Apache configurations by default allow configuration options within `.htaccess` files. Be sure that your Apache configuration has the necessary `AllowOverride` configuration to allow that `.htaccess` file to be processed (this is not the default on Debian Squeeze and other Linux distributions).
- Following an upgrade, failure to login due to `Auth.User.name` doesn't exist may be due to caches that need to be cleared.
- Messages like `Warning (2): preg_match(): Compilation failed: unknown option bit(s) set at offset -1 [CORE/Cake/Utility/Validation.php, line 782]` are indicative of a bad version of PCRE, described above.
