Notes

- There's a difference between compromising a credential and compromising a Kerberos ticket. As long as the tickets used by the IdP are
 protected, we probably don't need to worry so much about compromise of other tickets. It's still a security concern, but not specifically one
 affecting Silver compliance.
- It's not clear how secure AD's password-setting interfaces are. We'll ask Microsoft.
- Kerberos Armoring looks like it can help with RC4 encryption issues. NASA tells us, though, that it is not widely deployed, and it looks like it requires Windows 8. We'll ask Microsoft about this.
